MATH & MOVEMENT™

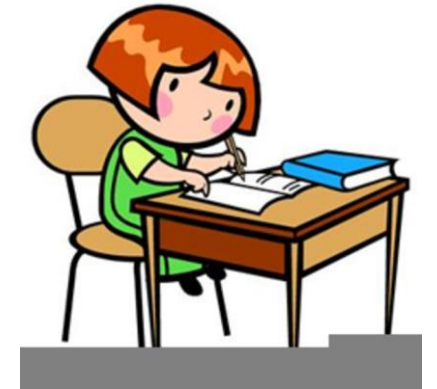


- **Math & Movement is a kinesthetic, multi-sensory approach to teaching math for grades PreK-Grade 5.**

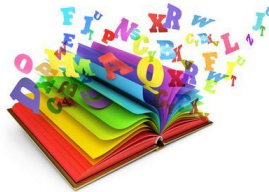
